



Why we recommend SOLID WOOD flooring:



- Adds value to your investment

TEAK

The "King" of Wood. Can be used indoor as well as outdoor, and is recognized as one of the best premium wood species in the world.

We have 15x90 and 15x120mm available in stock.





"NARRA" (Rosewood)

A Classic in the Philippines, and available from legal and sustainable source (Imported). – We have 15x90, 15x120mm as well as 21x145mm available in stock. We can also customize thicker/wider sizes.







MERBAU

Also known as "IPIL" in the Philippines. This is a very popular premium hardwood with a very nice glow, and very hard for heavy traffic. We have available stocks in 15x90 and 15x120mm and also 19x140mm.







KEMPAS

Kempas is a slightly cheaper version of the Merbau. A little more vivid color span for a beautiful hardwood flooring. – We have 15x90 and 15x120mm available in stock.







WALNUT

Our Asian Walnut as imported from Vietnam, and is a very hard variant of the popular Walnut flooring. We have this available in 15x120mm. We can also customize other sizes in Walnut.





"Tanguile" – Planks

The advantage of using "Tanguile" equivalents is that we can do longer lenghts, and wider boards. Often it would be stained for a more uniform finish.

ACACIA

Our Acacia is the plantation "Mangium" type, whichi s often used for a "Walnut" look although it is a bit more light in color. Popular and affordable. – Available in 18x90mm and 15x120mm







OAK

This is a European classic premium floor which we have available in 15x120mm. Some clients prefer a light stain on the wood, but it is also nice in natural color as shown.







OAK – Herringbone

There is a trend for residential as well as for commercial use to showcase the wood in the traditional herringbone pattern.

We have this available in stock in 15mm solid Oak.







This is a bit more modern European look which showcases the wood grain. Ash is lighter color than Oak, and popular for the Scandinavian look. – This is a product we normally customize to size.





PINE / SPRUCE

These softwoods are popular and affordable for mountain cabins, and also for bedrooms, and spa areas.




Dark Coco






Random lengths.

We often get specifications for 6ft flooring (which is often used for engineered and other non-solid wood solutions), but we prefer to offer "random lengths" which gives a more wholesome wood floor to look at, and also increases stability.

Furthermore the random lengths allow full utilization of the trees whereas the fixed lengths has 40-50% waste and thus also higher pricing.

Random lengths is thus cheaper, much more sustainable, and a better choice.





We have our own installation teams who have received the best professional training. We use proper tools including laser to ensure level straightness, and proper nail-guns. We only use top materials.
